

# OVERVIEW April 2025

- 1. From January to April 2025, Grenada's fiscal performance was generally in line with targets.
- 2. In April 2025, current revenue collections fell short of projections, mainly due to a decline in non-tax miscellaneous revenues and lower-than-expected grant inflows were realized. Current expenditures were kept below target levels. Capital expenditure saw a notable increase above target, reflecting continued strong implementation.
- 3. For April 2025, the primary and overall deficits were recorded at -\$20.7 million and -\$24.4 million, respectively, exceeding the monthly targets. However, for the January to April 2025 period, both the primary and overall deficits remained well within the established targets.





## FISCAL SUMMARY April 2025

- 1. Current Revenue for April 2025 was \$92.9m, which was \$4.2m less than the 2025 target and \$40.3m less than the collections for April 2024.
- 2. Total Grants in April 2025 amounted to \$3.3m which was \$1.8m less than the target and \$0.5m more than the actual in April 2024.
- 3. Total Current Expenditure, excluding Principal Repayments for the month of April was \$82.5m, which was \$2.2m less than the \$84.7m targeted.
- 4. Capital Expenditure in April 2025 was \$38.1m, \$23.4mm more than the amount spent in April 2024 and above the \$33.5m targeted for the month this year.





# FISCAL SUMMARY Cont'd April 2025

- 5. A Primary Balance (including Grants) of -\$20.7m was recorded for the month of April 2025, which was \$7.8m less than the month's target and \$75.7m less than the amount recorded in April 2024.
- 6. Total Principal Payments on Debt for April 2025 was \$12.0m, while Interest Payments totaled \$3.7m.
- 7. The Primary Balance, year-to-date, was \$4.5m, which was \$26.3m more than targeted but \$161.3m less than the amount recorded for January to April 2024.
- 8. The Overall Balance, year-to-date, was -\$9.6m, exceeding the -\$36.3m targeted for the period.
- 9. Total Principal and Interest Payments year-to-date were \$38.6m and \$14.1m, respectively.
