

OVERVIEW February 2025

- 1. Grenada's fiscal outturn exceeded targets over the January–February 2025 period.
- 2. In February 2025, current revenue collections overperformed mainly due to performance in tax revenues, however lower-than-expected grant inflows. Current expenditures remained below target, while capital spending surpassed projections, indicating strong implementation capacity.
- 3. The primary surplus stood at \$11.9 million and the overall surplus at \$8.7 million, both exceeding monthly targets. Cumulatively, for January–February, both balances remained above the fiscal benchmarks.





FISCAL SUMMARY February 2025

- 1. Current Revenue for February 2025 was \$104.9m, which was \$7.1m more than the 2025 target and \$12.8m less than the collections for February 2024.
- 2. Total Grants in February 2025 amounted to \$3.8m which was \$1.1m less than the target and \$0.2m less than the actual in February 2024.
- 3. Total Current Expenditure, excluding Principal Repayments for the month of February was \$63.7m, which was \$22.3m less than the \$86.0m targeted.
- 4. Capital Expenditure in February 2025 was \$36.3m, \$15.3m more than the amount spent in February 2024 and above the \$31.6m targeted for the month this year.





FISCAL SUMMARY Cont'd February 2025

- A Primary Balance (including Grants) of \$11.9m was recorded for the month of February 2025, which was \$23.5m more than the month's target but \$14.5m less than the amount recorded in February 2024.
- Total Principal Payments on Debt for February 2025 was \$18.0m, while Interest Payments totaled \$3.2m.
- 7. The Primary Balance, year-to-date, was \$26.8m, which was \$29.3m more than targeted but \$51.1m less than the amount recorded for January to February 2024.
- 8. The Overall Balance, year-to-date, was \$20.9m, exceeding the -\$8.1m targeted for the period.
- 9. Total Principal and Interest Payments year-to-date were \$24.8m and \$5.9m, respectively.

Ministry of Finance Total Principal Payment is the sum of Domestic and Foreign Payments.
