

OVERVIEW May 2025

- 1. From January to May 2025, Grenada's fiscal performance was generally in line with targets.
- 2. In May 2025, current revenue collections exceeded projections, mainly due to performance in taxes on International Transactions and IMA revenues, however lower-than-expected grant inflows were realized. Current expenditures were kept below target levels, while capital spending fell slightly short of projections.
- 3. For May 2025, the primary and overall deficits were recorded at -\$1.7 million and -\$4.7 million, respectively, exceeding the monthly targets.
- 4. Cumulatively, for the January to May 2025 period, both the primary and overall balances remained well within the established targets.





FISCAL SUMMARY May 2025

- 1. Current Revenue for May 2025 was \$106.2m, which was \$15.8m more than the 2025 target and \$13.7m less than the collections for May 2024.
- 2. Total Grants in May 2025 amounted to \$4.5m which was \$0.8m less than the target and \$4.0m more than the actual in May 2024.
- 3. Total Current Expenditure, excluding Principal Repayments for the month of May was \$80.9m, which was \$7.6m less than the \$88.5m targeted.
- 4. Capital Expenditure in May 2025 was \$34.5m, \$10.0m more than the amount spent in May 2024 but marginally below the \$35.5m monthly target for the year.





FISCAL SUMMARY Cont'd May 2025

- 5. A Primary Balance (including Grants) of -\$1.7m was recorded for the month of May 2025, which was \$20.9m less than the month's target and \$32.2m less than the amount recorded in May 2024.
- 6. Total Principal Payments on Debt for May 2025 was \$18.1m, while Interest Payments totaled \$3.0m.
- 7. The Primary Balance, year-to-date, was \$2.8m, which was \$47.2m more than targeted but \$193.6m less than the amount recorded for January to May 2024.
- 8. The Overall Balance, year-to-date, was -\$14.3m, exceeding the -\$64.6m targeted for the period.
- 9. Total Principal and Interest Payments year-to-date were \$56.7m and \$17.1m, respectively.
