IMF commences Article IV Consultation Mission to Grenada

The Government of Grenada announces the commencement of the 2025 Article IV Consultation Mission by the International Monetary Fund (IMF), taking place from October 20 to 29, 2025.

The 2025 mission is led by Mr. Janne Hukka, IMF Mission Chief for Grenada, and includes participation from representatives of the World Bank, Eastern Caribbean Central Bank (ECCB) and the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB).

Throughout the visit, the IMF team will engage with a wide range of stakeholders—including policymakers, senior government officials, technical experts, private sector leaders, trade unions, and civil society organizations—to assess the current state of Grenada's economy and discuss the Government's strategic priorities for sustainable growth and resilience.

This consultation is part of the IMF's regular surveillance activities under Article IV of its Articles of Agreement, which involves comprehensive reviews of member countries' economic and financial policies.

At the conclusion of the mission, the team will present its preliminary findings to the Government of Grenada. These findings will inform recommendations across key policy areas, including fiscal management, healthcare, pension reform, labor market development, and other critical sectors.

The Government of Grenada reaffirms its commitment to transparency, sound fiscal governance, and collaborative engagement with regional and international development partners in pursuit of its transformative national agenda.

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
