CENTRAL PROCUREMENT UNIT TO HOST TWO-DAY SYMPOSIUM ON STRENGTHENING PUBLIC PROCUREMENT

St. George's, Grenada, Jun 3 2026 – The Central Procurement Unit (CPU) within the Ministry of Finance, in collaboration with the Climate-Resilient Water Sector in Grenada (G-CREWS) Project, will host a two-day Procurement Symposium under the theme “Smart Bidding, Stronger Partnerships.” The event will take place on June 10 and 11, 2026, at the Radisson Beach Resort, Grand Anse, beginning at 9:00 a.m. daily.

The symposium will bring together public officers, contractors, suppliers, consultants, and key stakeholders involved in public procurement to deepen understanding of government procurement processes, strengthen compliance, and enhance collaboration between the public and private sectors.
