INLAND REVENUE DIVISION EXTENDS TAX FILING AND PAYMENT DEADLINE TO APRIL 30

St. George's, Grenada, March 31, 2026 - The Inland Revenue Division (IRD) wishes to sincerely thank individuals and businesses across Grenada for their continued cooperation and commitment to tax compliance and advises the public that the **deadline for filing and paying Personal Income Tax, Corporate Income Tax, and Annual Stamp Tax has been extended to April 30.**

This extension is intended to provide taxpayers with additional time to fulfill their obligations accurately and responsibly. The IRD acknowledges that taxpayers are a vital partner in national development, and we greatly appreciate those who consistently comply with their tax responsibilities.
