GOVERNMENT OF GRENADA TO PARTICIPATE IN HIGH-LEVEL REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON PORT REFORM AND DIGITALISATION

St. George's, Grenada, April 28, 2026 – Minister for Finance, Hon. Dennis Cornwall, departed the state today, Tuesday, April 28, to participate in a high-level regional workshop on Port Reform, Port Digitalisation, and Customs and Port Cooperation, scheduled to take place in Castries, Saint Lucia, from April 28 to 30, 2026.

The workshop is convened by the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS) Commission, in collaboration with the World Bank and the European Union, as part of a broader effort to strengthen connectivity, logistics, and trade facilitation across the Caribbean.

Minister Cornwall will attend the ministerial segment of the workshop and is accompanied by the Comptroller of Customs, Mrs. Karen Forsyth-Hall.

The engagement will bring together ministers, policymakers, and technical experts from across the region to examine key issues affecting port efficiency, regional competitiveness, customs cooperation, and the digital transformation of maritime operations.

The workshop also supports the advancement of the Caribbean Connectivity and Logistics Regional Programme, a strategic initiative designed to reduce logistical barriers, improve supply chain performance, and strengthen economic resilience across participating countries.

Grenada's engagement in this forum reflects its proactive approach to enhancing port operations and strengthening institutional collaboration across borders. The insights and outcomes from this workshop are expected to inform ongoing national efforts to improve efficiency within the maritime sector, support trade expansion, and position Grenada as a more competitive and resilient player in regional and global supply chains.
