### **GOVERNMENT EMBARKS ON SERIES OF CONSULTATIONS ON COVID-19**

**ST. GEORGE'S, GRENADA, AUGUST 30, 2021 – GIS:** The Government of Grenada is embarking on a series of virtual consultations with key stakeholders as part of efforts to drive greater collaboration in the fight against COVID-19.

The consultations will discuss measures to tackle the current spike in COVID-19 cases with a view to protecting lives and safe-guarding livelihoods.

The business community is regarded as a critical partner in the overall development of the country and as such, one of the consultations will be held with this sector.

Spearheaded by the Ministry of Finance, this virtual consultation session is scheduled for Thursday, September 2 at 2:00 pm.
